Console

There are many versions of the console, but the operation of the controls are the same.





The following is a guide to the operation:

The **blue** audio controls the signal levels to the speakers or headsets. You can listen to one to three signals at the same time by selecting the toggles. Radio one is on the left, two in the center and the third is on the right. The headset can receive radio one on the left earpiece; signal two on the right earpiece on the third signal on both. It takes a little practice it does work.

The red master audio is the output audio control for all the signals at once.

The red mic selection selects which transmitter you are using.

The **black** intercom allows the intercom to be used by an operator and a monitor.

The **black** speaker on/off selects if the speaker is in use or not.
