

Area 2 2m Simplex Net Script (146.445 MHz)

Black text-read every week. Green text-read during ORTs. Red text-instruction, do not read aloud.

AREA 2 SIMPLEX NET SCRIPT

This is (My Name...My call sign), Net Control this evening for the Ventura County Area 2 ARES/ACS Simplex check-in net on 146.445 megahertz.

If there is any emergency or priority traffic before I begin the net, please come now. **(Pause and listen for traffic.)**

Area 2 serves the Conejo Valley, including Newbury Park, Oak Park, and Thousand Oaks. This net operates every Tuesday at approximately 1850 hours local time with the exception of the first Tuesday of every month.

In addition to check-ins on this frequency, we are also accepting check-ins on these repeaters:

- 2 Meter band at 147.885, minus offset, with a PL of 127.3 at 1900,
- 440 band at 449.440, minus offset, with a PL of 131.8 from 1905 to 1915,
- 220 band at 224.700, minus offset, with a PL of 156.7 from 1915 to 1925.

If you can, please check in on these other nets.

For all those checking in, please give your call sign phonetically, your first name, ACS ID number if you have one, or state that you are ARES or a guest. I am accepting traffic for this net or any traffic to pass on to the county net. Since this is a Simplex net, relays are accepted. Please identify your station when relaying another to Net Control.

Any members, guests or visitors wishing to check in please come now.

End at approximately 1900 hours.
